

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF TRUSTEES DEUTSCHE BANK NATIONAL TRUST COMPANY AND DEUTSCHE BANK TRUST COMPANY AMERICAS' OBJECTIONS TO THE PLAN OF REHABILITATION FOR FINANCIAL GUARANTY INSURANCE COMPANY

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on November 19, 2012, Deutsche Bank National Trust Company and Deutsche Bank Trust Company Americas, each acting solely in their capacities as trustees (collectively the "<u>Trustees</u>") for certain residential mortgage-backed securities, other asset-backed securities, collateralized loan obligation, or collateralized debt obligation trusts (collectively the "<u>Trusts</u>") insured by policies issued by Financial Guaranty Insurance Company ("<u>FGIC</u>"), filed an objection (the "<u>Initial Objection</u>") to the Plan of Rehabilitation for Financial Guaranty Insurance Company (the "<u>Proposed Plan</u>")

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, on January 22, 2013, in accordance with an order of the Court dated January 7, 2013, the Trustees filed an amended objection (collectively with the Initial Objection, the "Objections").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the court-appointed rehabilitator of FGIC (the "Rehabilitator") has proposed certain amended terms to the Proposed Plan (the "Plan Revisions") if the Trustees and certain other trustees withdraw their objections.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with an order of the Court dated February 19, 2013 (the "February 19 Order"), the Trustees served notice of the Plan Revisions to certain stakeholders in the Trusts.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with the February 19 Order and the representations of the Rehabilitator, the Trustees hereby withdraw the Objections.
